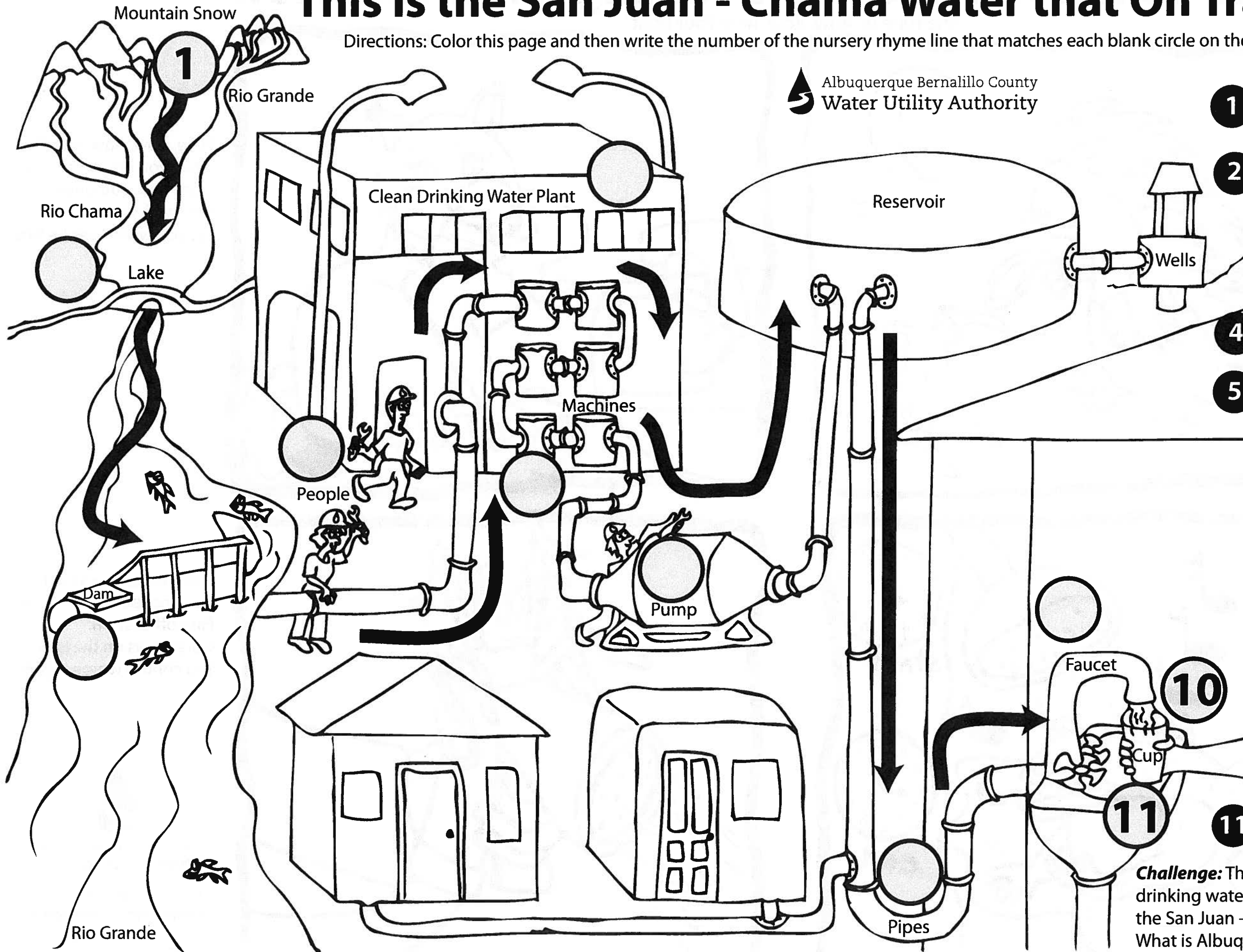
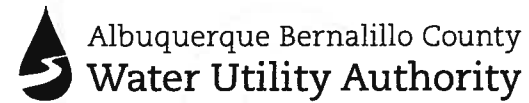


This is the San Juan - Chama Water that On Track Jack Drank
