

## **SAN JUAN-CHAMA DRINKING WATER PROJECT** **BURTON PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE!!!**

### ***Securing Our Future Water Supply***

**NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.**

Due to cold weather temperatures, paving operations have been delayed. Crews cannot lay pavement until the temperature is at least 40 degrees Fahrenheit or above. The following construction areas have been affected:

- ♣ **MARQUETTE BETWEEN SAN MATEO & TRUMAN**
- ♣ **MARQUETTE BETWEEN SAN MATEO & ORTIZ**
- ♣ **HERMOSA BETWEEN MARQUETTE & GRAND**
- ♣ **WELLESLEY BETWEEN SAN JOAQUIN & SANTA CLARA**

These areas are scheduled to be paved and open to traffic by **January 26**, pending outside weather temperatures of 40 degrees or higher.



### **AREAS WHERE WORK IS ONGOING:**

- (Pershing is closed east and west of Carlisle through the **end of January** – Crews are completing installation of a pipeline.
- (Hermosa is closed from Grand to Copper through the **end of February** – Crews are completing installation of a tunnel and a pipeline.
- (Hermosa is closed from Central to Silver through the **end of February** – Crews are completing a tunnel, laying pipeline through the tunnel and connecting pipeline.
- (Santa Clara is closed from Wellesley to

Amherst through the **end of January** – Crews are installing a pipeline.

(Amherst is closed from Santa Clara to Pershing through the **end of January** – Crews are installing pipeline.

**ACCESS WILL BE MAINTAINED TO ALL LOCAL RESIDENCES.** However traffic may be restricted somewhat in the direct area where crews are working. General work hours will be **7 a.m.-5 p.m. Monday-Friday** and **8 a.m.-5 p.m. Saturdays**, although crews may occasionally work longer hours if needed.
