Conservation Detective

Teacher Directions:

In this game, students see if they can pick the picture that shows the person who is conserving or saving water. The following files contain two pictures that are very similar, but there is one difference: in one picture the person is saving water, and in the other picture the person is wasting water.

Run off the 4 pages of each file. Attach the rule to the back of the water saver picture. Attach the "Keep Looking" page to the back of the water waster picture.

Present both pictures to the students and ask, "Which person is saving water?" If the student turns over the water waster picture, it says "Keep Looking." When they turn over the other picture, it will give them a rule (in Spanish and English) to help them save water and some points. It's more fun if you come up with a hand motion to help them remember each rule.

If you would like to have each student take a turn, but you have more than 13 students, you can reuse cards that have already been shown. This time the student has to tell you the rule or the hand motion you gave them to help them remember the rule.
