

## **SAN JUAN-CHAMA DRINKING WATER PROJECT** **BURTON PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION PAVING UPDATE!!!**

### ***Securing Our Future Water Supply***

***NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.***

Starting the **week of March 24**, paving crews will begin asphalt milling and overlay operations to improve portions of streets in the areas located below. Preparation and re-paving will be done in sections. Prepping an area will take approximately 2 days and re-paving each area will take approximately 1-2 days.

#### **1<sup>st</sup> WORK AREA:**

On **Alvarado** from **Roma** to **Marquette**, then on **Marquette** from **Alvarado** to **San Mateo**



#### **2<sup>nd</sup> WORK AREA:**

On **Marquette** from **San Mateo** to **Washington**



Your patience is appreciated. Access will be restricted after asphalt has been laid in order to allow it to cool. Motorists may experience some delays.

**Work hours will generally be from 7 a.m. – 7 p.m. Monday-Friday and 8 a.m.-6 p.m. on Saturdays.** During working hours, **no parking on the affected streets** will be greatly appreciated.
