

## **CHARLES WELLS PIPELINE**

### **UPDATE - CONSTRUCTION ON ALVARADO DRIVE NE**

ERS is continuing construction on Alvarado Drive NE as part of the Transmission Line No. 2, Phase 2 -- Charles Wells. Because ERS is performing a number of activities on Alvarado, we've included a list of what will be done, in order, prior to completion of construction in this area (estimated in June 2007). **Please note that you may not always see work going on.** Some of these activities require crews to be working underground. Therefore, you may see only a few crew members working on the surface of the road.

- 1) Install temporary water line from Marble to Roma. (This allows residents to have water during construction.)
- 2) Connect homes to the temporary water line. (This will require about 1-2 hours per home.)
- 3) Remove asphalt from the pipeline side of the street. *On Alvarado from Haines to Marble, the pipeline will be laid on the east side of the street. On Alvarado from Marble to Roma, the pipeline will be laid on the west side of the street.*
- 4) Install 42" water transmission line. *On Alvarado from Haines to Marble, the pipeline will be laid on the east side of the street. On Alvarado from Marble to Roma, the pipeline will be laid on the west side of the street.*
- 5) Install a new 6" water service line. *On Alvarado from Summer to Roma, the water service line will be laid along the same path as the 42" water transmission line.*
- 6) Connect homes to the new 6" water line. NOTE: Homes on the east side of Alvarado between Summer and Roma will have new water meters installed.
- 7) Install 1.5 inches of asphalt on the side of the street where the pipeline was installed.
- 8) Remove 1.5 inches of asphalt on the other side of the street to make the roadway more even until final paving.
- 9) Demolish existing sidewalk, curb and gutter. Re-install new sidewalk, curb and gutter.
- 10) Add the final course of pavement on both sides of the street (from curb to curb).

#### **IMPORTANT NOTICE: CREWS MAY ASK TO VIDEOTAPE YOUR PROPERTY**
