

## SAN JUAN-CHAMA DRINKING WATER PROJECT VOLCANO PIPELINE-NORTH SEGMENT UPDATE!!! *Securing Our Future Water Supply*

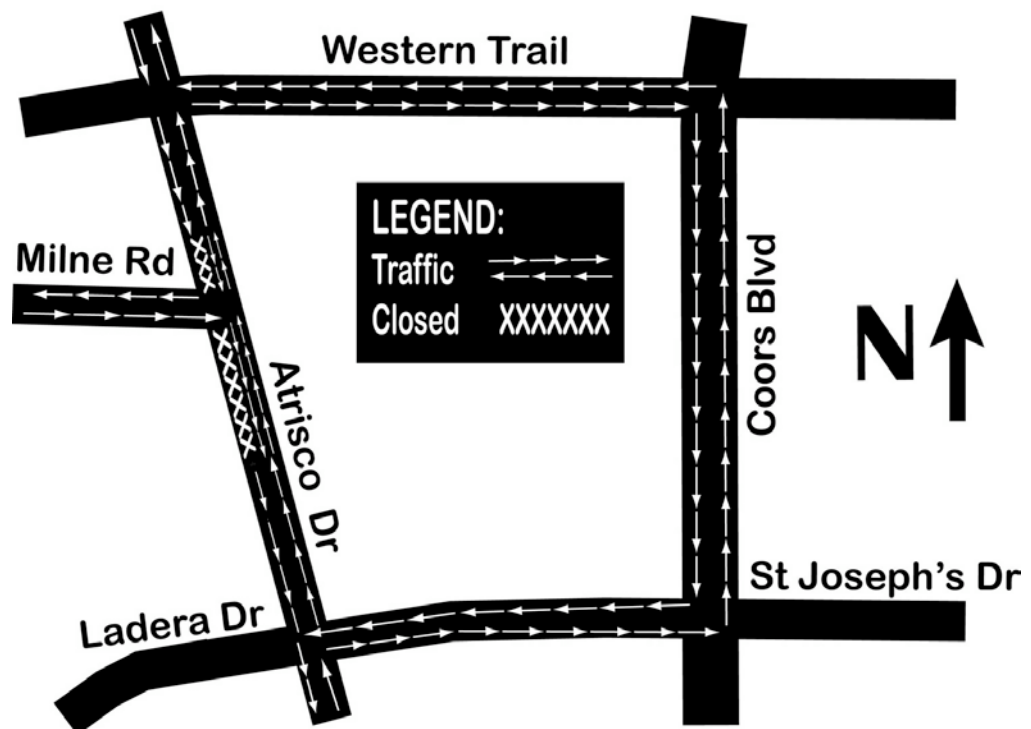
**NOTE:** All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.

**Beginning Friday, January 19**, crews will remove and re-lay approximately 400 feet of 36" pipeline on Atrisco Drive from north of Milne Road to south of Milne Road to correct the pipeline's alignment. This work is expected to last through **February 2, 2007**.

Crews will be working on the **west** side of Atrisco Drive and traffic will be shifted to the **east** side of the roadway. Crews will work from south to north on Atrisco.

One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction on Atrisco Drive and on Milne Road.

**ACCESS WILL BE MAINTAINED TO ALL LOCAL SCHOOLS, CHURCHES, BUSINESSES AND RESIDENCES.**



**Work hours will be 7 a.m.-9 p.m. Monday-Friday and 8 a.m.-9 p.m. Saturday and Sunday**, although crews may occasionally work longer to complete critical components of the project. **Southbound motorists on Atrisco** can use **Western Trail to Coors** as an alternative route. **Northbound motorists on Atrisco** can use **Ladera/St. Joseph's to Coors** as an alternative route.
