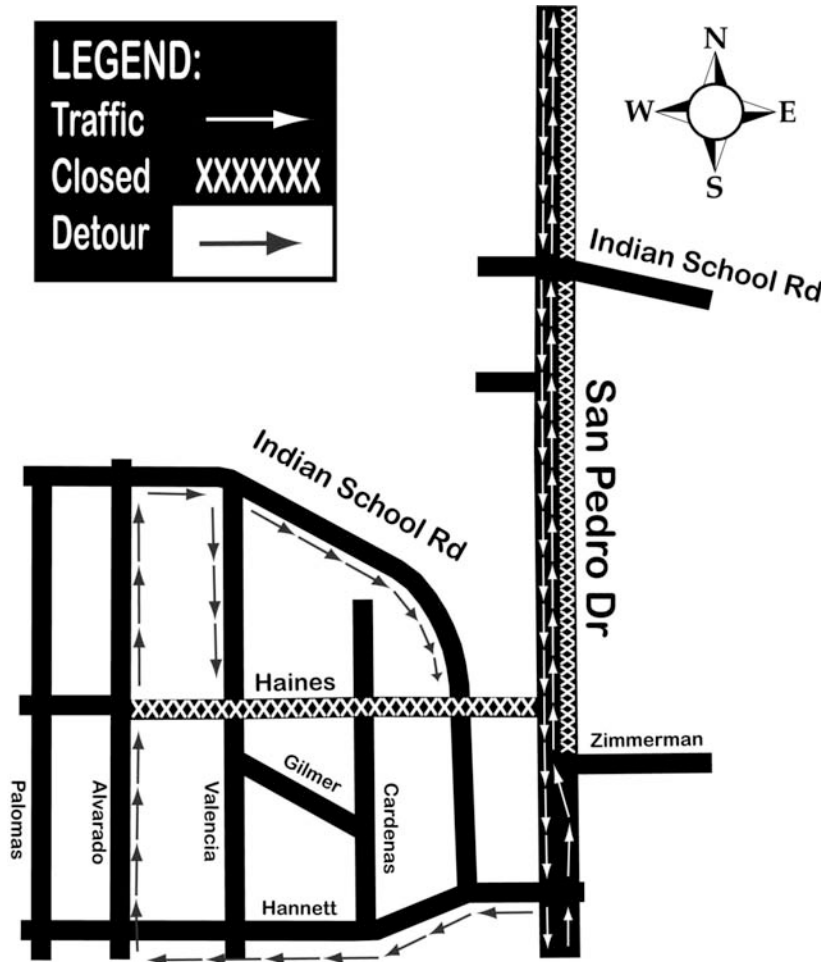


SAN JUAN-CHAMA DRINKING WATER PROJECT
CHARLES WELL PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION MOVING
TO NEXT PHASE IN EARLY JANUARY
Securing Our Future Water Supply

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.



Starting **Monday, January 8, 2007**, crews will begin work on **San Pedro Drive** and, shortly there after, on **Haines** as part of the San Juan-Chama Drinking Water Project Pipeline No. 2, Phase 2-Charles Wells. On **San Pedro Drive south of Menaul Blvd.**, traffic will be shifted to the southbound lanes with one lane of traffic open in each direction. **ACCESS WILL BE MAINTAINED TO ALL LOCAL BUSINESSES.**

Haines will be closed to through traffic from just east of Alvarado to just west of San Pedro Drive. **ACCESS WILL BE MAINTAINED TO ALL LOCAL RESIDENCES.** Motorists can use **Hannett, Alvarado** and **Indian School Road** as alternate routes.

This phase of work is expected to last through early April 2007. **Work hours will be 7 a.m.-7 p.m. Monday-Friday and 8 a.m.-5 p.m. Saturday, although crews may occasionally work longer hours if needed.**

IMPORTANT NOTICE: CREWS MAY ASK TO VIDEOTAPE YOUR PROPERTY

A representative from ERS, the contractor, may contact you at least three weeks before the time construction crews are scheduled to be in a "work zone" that includes your property to request permission to videotape exterior and interior structures.
