

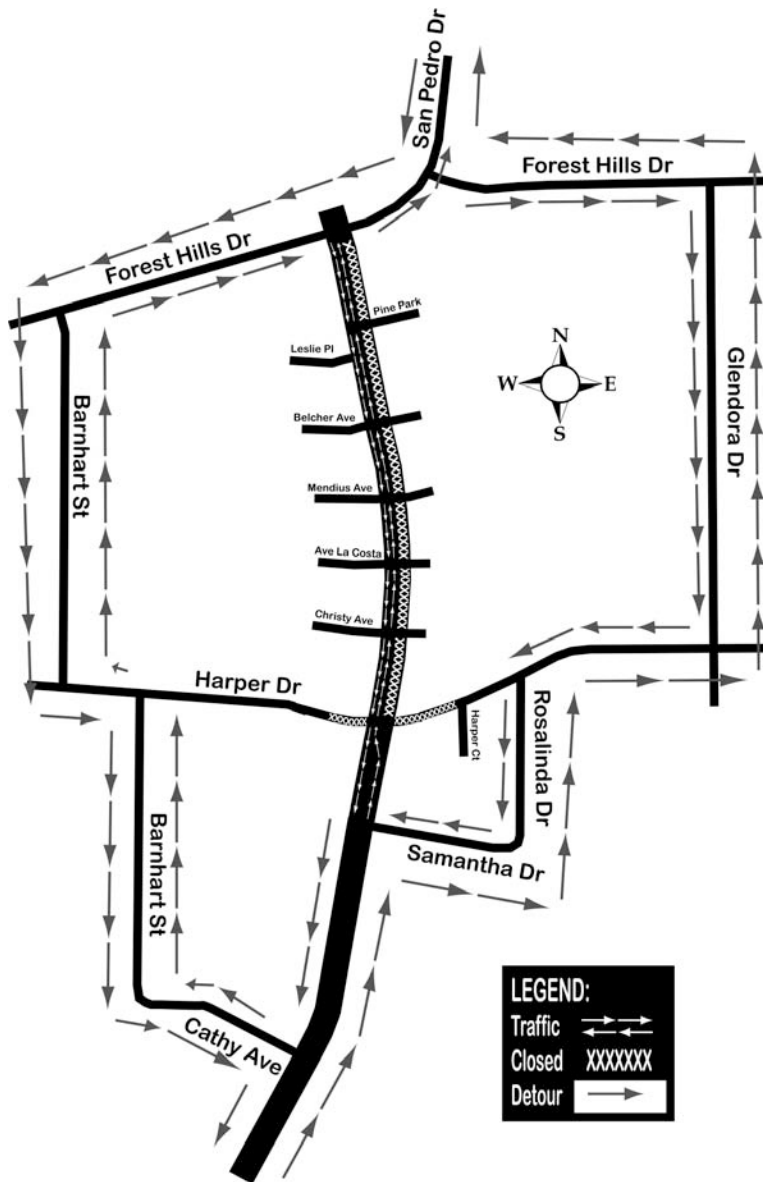

CORONADO PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE!!!

CREWS TO CROSS HARPER THEN CONTINUE SOUTH ON MCKINNEY

Securing Our Future Water Supply

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.



From **Saturday, Jan. 27-Sunday, Jan. 28**, Harper Drive will be **closed** to only to east and west bound traffic at the intersection of McKinney and Harper Drive. **Northbound and southbound traffic will be allowed** through the intersection, but **no right or left turns** onto or from Harper will be allowed. This work is being done during the weekend to minimize inconvenience to area residents and commuter traffic. **Northbound motorists can use Cathy to Barnhart or Samantha to Rosalinda** as alternate routes or use the **Pan American Freeway**. **Southbound motorists can use Forest Hills to Glendora or Barnhart or Louisiana to Burlison** as alternate routes.

On **February 3-4**, crews are expected to pave the intersection of McKinney and Harper. During paving operations, **no right turns** onto Harper will be permitted for **northbound motorists on McKinney** and **no left turns** onto Harper will be permitted for **southbound motorists on McKinney**. **ALL ACCESS WILL BE MAINTAINED DURING THE WEEKDAYS**. **ACCESS TO ARROYO DEL OSO ELEMENTARY SCHOOL WILL BE MAINTAINED**.

As work progresses south on McKinney, traffic will continue to be shifted to the **west side of McKinney** with **one lane open in each direction** as work progresses. Crews will continue to work in **approximately three-block segments** on the eastside of McKinney. Several blocks will be paved at one time, so roadways may be packed dirt or gravel for a short period of time prior to paving. **NOTE: As crews cross individual streets, they may need to shut down intersections for a short time. Crews will coordinate with residents of these streets in advance. Also, as crews cross driveways with the pipeline, they will coordinate in advance with residents on access concerns.**
