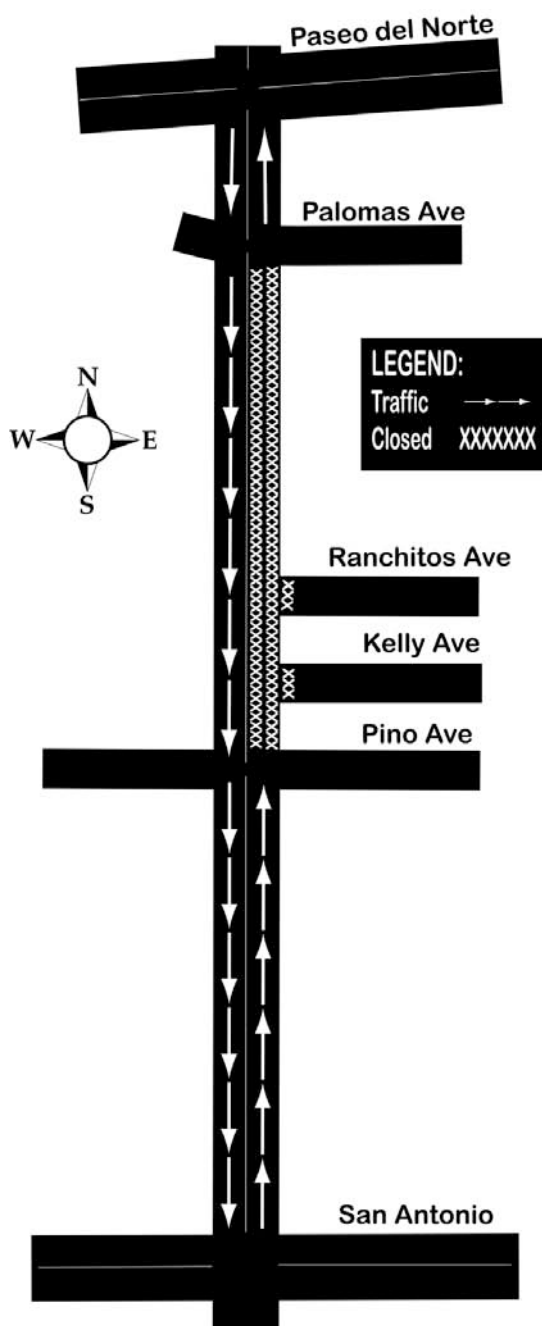


SAN JUAN-CHAMA DRINKING WATER PROJECT
CORONADO PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE
NORTHBOUND SAN PEDRO TO BE COMPLETELY
CLOSED STARTING JANUARY 11, 2007
Securing Our Future Water Supply

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.



Construction on the San Juan-Chama Drinking Water Project Coronado Pipeline construction is scheduled to begin its next phase on **January 11, 2007**, on **San Pedro Drive NE**. The **northbound lanes** of San Pedro will be closed from just north of Pino Ave. NE to just south of Palomas Ave. NE, with **ONLY ONE LANE OF SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC ALLOWED**. ACCESS WILL BE MAINTAINED TO PINO YARDS, AS WELL AS TO ALL LOCAL RESIDENCES AND BUSINESSES.

Motorists can use **LOUISIANA BLVD. NE** or the **I-25 NORTHBOUND FRONTAGE ROAD** as **alternate routes**.

A 30" water line is being installed on the east side of San Pedro Drive. Crews are scheduled to bore (tunnel) under the Domingo Baca Arroyo at San Pedro with the pipeline and will be working from north to south.

Upon completion of the pipeline installation, they will restore the roadway back to its original condition. **This phase of work is expected to last through March 2007**. Work hours will generally be 7:00 a.m.- 6:00 p.m. Monday - Friday, although crews may also work on Saturday and Sunday as needed.
