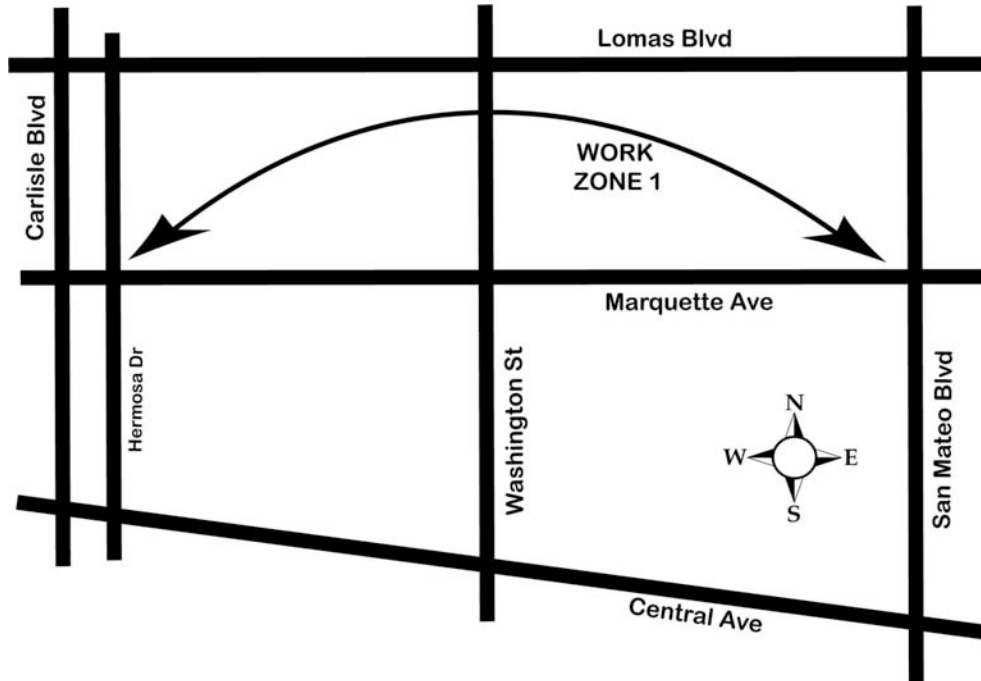


SAN JUAN-CHAMA DRINKING WATER PROJECT BURTON PIPELINE – CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN ON WORK ZONE 1

Securing Our Future Water Supply

NOTE: All work is scheduled weather permitting and is subject to change without notice.



Starting late the week of August 20th, a crew will begin installing temporary water services to homes on **Marquette between San Mateo and Monroe**. Water will be temporarily turned off at times; however, crews will notify residents in advance. **Another crew will start installing the large diameter pipeline on Marquette just west of San Mateo the week after Labor Day**. There will also be a small diameter pipeline crew that will install a new 6" waterline on **Marquette from San Mateo to Hermosa**. The roadway will be kept open during the 6" waterline installation and flagmen will be on-site to assist with directing traffic as necessary. Motorists should expect delays. Water shut offs will occur

while this crew is working on your block, but homeowners will be notified in advance.

While the crew installing the large diameter pipeline the road is expected to be **totally closed in 3-block segments** during this operation. **ACCESS WILL BE MAINTAINED TO RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES**, however, you should expect delays. The large diameter pipeline installation could take place 4-6 weeks after the 6" new waterline has been installed. Once both crews have completed their installations, the road will be **paved and open to traffic within 4-6 weeks of the large 42" diameter pipeline installation** (weather permitting). **While crews are working in front of driveways, residents will be asked to park in an alternative nearby location for up to one day.** Crews will coordinate with homeowners in order to maintain access to homes. **EMERGENCY SERVICE ACCESS WILL BE PROVIDED IF NEEDED** (*ambulances, police, fire trucks.*) Mail delivery should not be affected. Crews will coordinate garbage pickup with the city and will mark garbage containers with addresses and move them where they can be picked up and emptied if needed. Crews will install a tunnel for the large diameter pipeline under San Mateo Boulevard which will start in mid-late October. **All activity in this work zone should be completed by the end of October (weather permitting).**

IMPORTANT NOTICE: CREWS MAY ASK TO VIDEOTAPE YOUR PROPERTY - A representative from ERS, the contractor, may contact you prior to the time construction crews are scheduled to be in a "work zone" that includes your property to request permission to videotape exterior and interior structures. This is optional. Contact Pete Dobbs (see numbers below) for more information. Videotaping permission forms will be hand delivered by an ERS employee and videotaping can be scheduled with the homeowner.
