
# Coolscape

## Coolscape

This Coolscape is designed to provide an attractive streetside landscape as well as a comfortable, private area that is useable even in the winter. The privacy is achieved by the use of a low wall (which should match or complement the house) and a grove of small trees, such as New Mexico Olives or Chaste Trees. The placement of the trees effectively adds to the privacy, and provides a backdrop along the edge of the brick patio.

The patio was placed to provide some sun even on an east exposure. Beneath the trees, a groundcover of Wooly Thyme and Blue Fescue grows in the sunnier spots and Kinnickkinnick in those most shady. For best use of rainwater, the brick patio should be canted to drain away from the house and into the surrounding planting beds. The edge of the patio on the north side of the yard ends in a bed of fine crushed gravel to create a path to the rear yard. Plants that do best on the cold north exposure of homes, such as compact Oregon Grape Holly and Indian Hawthorn, are used to cope with the lack of sun, which in turn makes them more drought tolerant. Likewise, Arizona Rosewood is used along the south exposure to capture as much warmth and sun as possible. Lastly, Buffalograss is planted along the front easternmost portion of the yard where it will be the most drought tolerant.
